STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

The request is designed to continue on-going programs in serving students, including orientation, assessment, placement, instruction, evaluation & guidance, of the scholarly academic progress; in our community, inclusive of adult educational needs and community service projects and research.

Our FY2025 request reflects those funding priorities established by the Board which include Education Enhancement Funds in the amount of \$12,467,625 and Capital Expense Funds in the amount of \$2,838,046 for Campus R&R. Of the \$12,456,055 of EEF provided for FY 2023, \$5,000,000 was provided to defray the expenses related to the repair, renovation, and/or construction of a residence hall (SB3002 sec #42) and \$250,000 to fund both research and upgrades to the physical space in order to perform research and entrepreneurship. A total of \$5,250,000 in EEF was reappropriated fo FY 2024.

The request is designed to continue on-going programs in serving students, including orientation, assessment, placement, instruction, evaluation & guidance, of the scholarly academic progress; in our community, inclusive of adult educational needs and community service projects and research.
