- Recruiting, Selecting, and Training Peer Network Members
- Conducting Stage-Based Encounters
- Distribution of Health Fact Sheets
- Distribution of Role Model Stories
- Establishing a Community Network
- Conducting Small Group Activities
- Conducting HIV Prevention Presentations
- Participating in Outreach Projects
- Offering Referrals for HIV Testing
